Merilatt Cabinets, Doors, Millwork Locksets, Heatilator fireplaces and more.

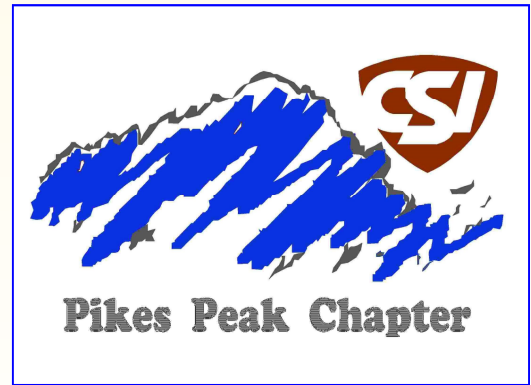

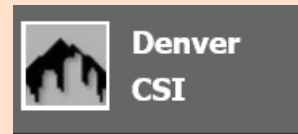
Join us at WinterGreen!

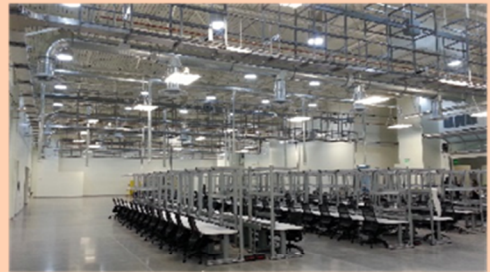
