ASTM E2357 vs. ASTM E1677

Join us this month for a presentation by Jim Holt, on the difference between ASTM E2357 and ASTM E1677. Learning objectives for this presentation are:

- ◇ Understand the impact of air leakage, the importance of air barriers for air leakage control, and the current air barrier codes and standards.
- ◇ Understand the design criteria for air barrier performance and current standards for testing the performance of installed air barriers.
- ◇ Learn about the differences between ASTM E1677 and ASTM E2357 air barrier performance level.

CSI's Construction Documents Technologist (**CDT**) certificate is a prerequisite to CSI's Certifications: Certified Construction Contract Administrator (**CCCA**); Certified Construction Specifier (**CCS**) and Certified Construction Product Representative (**CCPR**).
